

HOW TO ENTER

- Student to complete the section to the right --→
- (Teacher to summarise all entries on to School Control Sheet)
- email to: atwelart@inet.net.au (heading: Atwell Youth Awards)
by 4.00pm Thursday 24 May 2018
- Entry Fee: An entry fee of \$5.00 or \$10 per entry
(see fee guidelines below)
- Arrange Payment by Cheque (payable to MCAA) or email Atwell to arrange for an invoice to your school.

FEE GUIDELINES

• What will be classified as ONE entry – \$5.00 per entry

- An individual may enter only ONE artwork which may contain a maximum of 3 closely related parts.

• Art Project / Installation (involving 6 or more students) \$10.00

- One exhibit with one title, one shared idea and multiple participants working together. This exhibit can be hung from the gallery ceiling or displayed on the floor or on stands. (Teachers will need to supply own stands and organise set up of display).

• What will be classified as multiple entry Fees

- Individual work by **class members** on the same subject will be regarded as **separate entries**. Individual entry forms and fees apply. (Teacher will need to pre-select works—maximum of 9 pieces with the same subject matter).

5. MCAA reserves the right to refuse any entry considered unsuitable for general exhibition.
6. None of the exhibited artworks are for sale.
7. All entries must be the original, creative work of the Artist. Artwork cannot be copied, either wholly or in part from any published article. Personally owned photographs may be used as reference for subject matter.
8. The artist agrees that the Atwell Arts Centre reserves the right to reproduce entries (in whole or in part) in print, film or digital format for promotion, education and documentation in association with the Award.
