His inspiration comes from the abstract and bizarre and the relationships between the natural world, the human body and the creative brain.

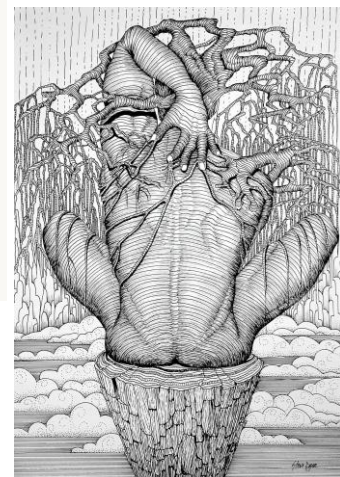
